Workforce Development is Economic Development

Colorado Child Care Assistance Program (CCCAP)

You may qualify for child care assistance if...

- ⇒ You are employed (2 parent homes, both parents must be in an eligible activity)
- ⇒ Or in school (college, high school or certificate program)

Program Eligibility: Monthly gross (before taxes) income (earned & un-earned) below 185% poverty level

Providers: We have contracts with over 50 licensed centers including Extended Hours and over 40 licensed home providers.

How to Apply:

An interview is required for all new applications. We will need the following documents to process your application:

- current photo ID
- state-issued birth certificates for children
- proof of residence
- work schedule, and 30 days' paystubs
- name of school attending and verification of enrollment and class schedule
- child support compliance for one parent households.

Apply at the Mesa County Workforce Center Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday 8am-4:30pm and Wednesday 8am-noon
